

Increasing biodiversity in a highly modified but unique landscape

- Shell Chenier ridges with wet silty hollows
- Wetland used for food gathering and flax harvest 1800's
- Chenier ridges mined for shell burnt and crushed to make lime 1930-1950's
- Area drained, native vegetation burnt and pasture grasses sown for grazing stock until ~2015-7
